Membership...

(Dues Are \$12.00 Per Year)

All CPAAA - North members must complete a Citizens Police Academy course conducted by the St Louis County Police Department prior to making an application for membership. Persons completing a course outside of the North County region, must provide proof of course completion with this application. A \$12.00 annual membership fee must be paid with this application.

The CPAAA - North is led by a Board of Directors nominated from the association membership and elected by the members and is governed in accordance with Bylaws established by the membership and approved by the St Louis County Police Department.

Each year association members are provided many opportunities to assist the STLCPD with activities and functions which do not require a sworn officer or civilian employee of the STLCPD to perform. All such volunteer activities are conducted at the request of the STLCPD and under its supervision. All CPAAA - North Members are issued an association picture I.D. badge which must be worn during CPAAA activities. At no time, or for any reason, may a CPAAA - North Member use his or her CPAAA I.D. Badge, logoed attire or logoed merchandise to identify as, or to infer or imply he or she is a Police Officer, Employee or Agent with the St. Louis Police Department. Doing so is a violation of CPAAA Bylaws and State and Federal Laws that prohibit the impersonation of a law enforcement official, and will result in expulsion from the CPAAA and possible criminal prosecution. CPAAA logoed attire and merchandise purchased by a member is the property of the member. However, CPAAA I.D. Badges are the property of the STLCPD and must be returned to a CPAAA - North official when the member leaves the association.
